At Home

Keep practicing counting on and back to 20, and beyond. Start and finish from different numbers. Recognise numbers as you walk along the road, spot buses etc. Any board game is great for this and there are some fun activities on the ICT games and Topmarks websites.

It is school policy to read with your child at least three times a week. Please record this in their Reading Records. If you complete two or more of the Little Wandle sessions in one evening please record so we can track all their reading. Also encourage them to read their own books and comics. Oxford Owl is a good website for extra eBooks.

They will bring home a book from the school library. This will be a book of their choice that they find it to be interesting. Children are welcome to continue to read books from home that they enjoy.

What are we learning this half term?

In **English** we are continuing to listen to stories and retell them in our own words. We will look at the simple structure and any patterns.

7-4 = 3


In **Science**, we are focusing on materials and their properties.
