

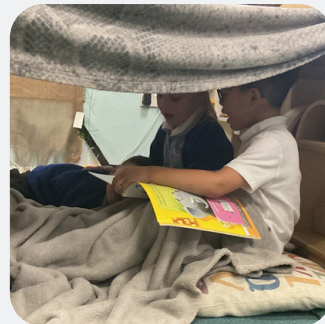
## Dear Parents and Carers
