Dear Parents and Carers,

Summer Term 2026

Your children will continue to be taught by Mr Warwick (Wildcats) and Miss Mathewson (Moorhens) from Monday to Friday. Mrs Bishop and Miss Godrich will regularly cover lessons. The school gates open at 8:40am and register will be taken at 8:50am. **Please remember to be on time, as learning begins at 8:40 each day.**

Children are expected to wear the correct school uniform, including **plain black shoes or trainers**, a white polo shirt and grey skirt/trousers. Children can wear a plain, stud earring in each ear if they wish. Hairbands should be plain and no other jewellery (necklaces/bracelets etc) should be worn. Please make sure the long hair is tied up, especially on PE days.

At Home

Your child should be regularly bringing home a reading book that is matched to their reading level.

It is your child's responsibility to get their book out of their bag in the morning – some children have been forgetting to do this and reading records are going several days without being checked. Please prompt them to return their reading record if you notice that it hasn't been signed by an adult in school.

We are continuing with our spelling lessons and tests on Fridays this half term. There are some difficult spelling lists coming up and the children will need to put in some extra effort at home to learn these words – we have noticed that lots of spelling books are left in trays and table trays!

Thank you for your support with logging onto TT Rockstars – it really helps the children with their recall of times tables and related facts. Please remember that Hit the Button is a useful website for practicing too! By the end of year 2, children working at the expected level in Maths should be confident in 2, 5 and 10 times tables and the best way to achieve this is to practise, practice, practice!

What are we learning this half term?

In **English**, we will be basing our writing around *Fantastic Mr Fox* by Roald Dahl as well as *The Barnabus Project* by the Fan brothers. We will be writing creatively about both texts that we will be studying.

In **Maths**, our new learning will be focused around *time, movement* and *statistics* whilst also consolidating our skills of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Our **Geography** focus for this half term is based around the topic question *How does my life compare to life in Filey?* We will be studying human and physical features of Halton and will compare these to Filey when we visit in July.

In **Art**, we will be exploring *textiles and collages*.

In **RE**, the children will continue to learn about *the life of Jesus and his teaching* and our **PSHE** learning will be focused around *Changing Me*.

Things to remember...

P.E Days

Year 2's P.E. days are **Mondays**. On this day, please wear your PE kit to school. PE kit is as follows: plain white t-shirt, school jumper (old or new), black shorts, leggings or jogging bottoms and plain trainers. PE will be outside throughout the year so children should be prepared for this weather.

Jewellery should not be worn during PE lessons. Earrings that can't be removed should be taped over.

What to bring to school

Children should bring bookbags each day so please avoid sending children in with large rucksacks as space in the cloakroom is limited.

Please make sure that all sun hats are labelled as some of these have already gone missing. Sun cream can be applied before school, or by your child during the day. They must be able to do it themselves and won't be allowed to share sunscreen.
