The school gates open at 8:40am and register will be taken at 8:50am. If you are later than 8.55am, the gates will be closed and you will need to report to the front office. Please try to be on time as missing out on a few minutes can have a big impact on a child's day.

Children are expected to wear the correct school uniform, including black shoes or trainers, a white polo shirt and grey skirt/trousers. Children can wear a plain, stud earring in each ear if they wish. Hairbands should be plain. Children can wear a watch but no other jewellery (necklaces/bracelets etc) should be worn.

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL JUMPERS AND CARDIGANS ARE NAMED CLEARLY. As the weather gets warmer children take them off and they can get misplaced and mixed up.

At Home

Practice counting on and back to 100, start and finish from different numbers. Please practise telling the time on an analogue clock to the hour and half hour. Also help your child to recognise each of the coins and understand their value.

It is school policy to read with your child at least three times a week. Please record this in their Reading Records.

They will bring home a book from the school library. This will be a book of their choice that they find it to be interesting. Children are welcome to continue to read books from home that they enjoy. These will be changed every Tuesday. Please ensure these come back each week. The number of children bringing them back is currently very low.

Our ongoing Science Topic is Seasonal change so please discuss what is happening with the weather and how this changes over the next couple of months.

What are we learning this half term?

In **English** we are going to be looking at recounts, descriptive writing and setting descriptions.

We will be continuing writing sentences - being more consistent with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We have the Phonics Screening in June, and daily phonics will continue as usual.

In **Maths** we will be covering numbers to 100. We will also be recognising all the coins. We will start to learn about fractions, concentrating on halves and quarters of shapes.

In **Science** our topic is Plants. We will be naming the main parts of a flower and what they do.

Our **History** topic for this half term is all about the Local Legends. We will be learning about different people from our area, past and present.

Key Texts this half term

This half term, we will be looking at the texts *A Seed is Sleepy* and *Where the Wild Things Are*.

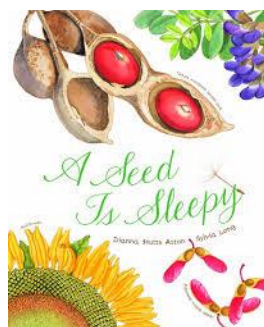
We will use these texts to write descriptive writing and story settings. We will be focusing on the use of adjectives to add detail. We will also be using time conjunctions to order our diaries including:
