



Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 5 – Autumn 2



I know the multiplication and division facts for all times tables up to **12 x 12**.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

Children should know all of these facts by the end of year 4.

This will be consolidation of these facts.

Key Vocabulary

What is 8 **multiplied by** 6?

What is 7 **times** 4?

What is 81 **divided by** 9?

What is the **product** of 5 and 7?

They should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions e.g. $6 \times \bigcirc = 42$ or $\bigcirc \div 8 = 4$

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You do not need to practise them all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.
